Florence Nightingale was born in 1820. She was the only child in the family and her parents had enough money to buy her whatever she asked for. Most women in those days were expected to marry and bring up children, not to take a job. But Florence was different — she wanted to be a nurse. She went around Europe with her father and during those trips she visited hospitals. She took notes on hygiene, hospital management and the design of wards, as well as on the work of the doctors.

Then, at the age of thirty-one, she spent three months studying nursing. During the Crimean War, she was asked to help with the injured soldiers. So in 1854, she went to a place called Scutari with thirty-eight other nurses. Conditions were terrible. The wounded soldiers lay on the dirty floor of the hospital. There were no medical supplies and not even any toilets.

Florence decided to take action. She set up a kitchen and fed the soldiers well. She also arranged for toilets to be dug and the hospital to be cleaned. Within six months, the death rate of the soldiers was reduced from 60% to an amazing 20%. Florence went round the wards talking to the soldiers, who called her 'the lady with the lamp'. Now she is known to everyone as the founder of modern nursing.
