

READING 2 (Items 6 – 10)

Read the text, and then complete the task on page 5.

Charles Lindbergh is one of the most famous pilots who have ever lived. In 1927, when he was just twenty-five years old, he became the first man to fly across the Atlantic Ocean alone. He arrived in Paris on 21 May after a 34-hour flight from New York. One hundred thousand people were at the airport to welcome him.

Lindbergh was born in a small town in the United States. He was not a very good student, and after leaving school, he helped his father on the family farm. But he also discovered a new exciting hobby — flying. His first flight was in 1920 when he was only eighteen years old, and he soon became an excellent pilot.

After his amazing flight across the Atlantic, Lindbergh became world-famous and very rich, even though he stopped flying. He also got to know many other famous people in the United States. But being a celebrity did not make him happy. So he decided to move to Europe to start a new life.

In 1953, he told the story of his life in an auto-biography called "The Spirit of St Louis" — the name of the plane in which he had crossed the Atlantic. Later, he wrote a second book, which was about the need to stop pollution and to protect endangered species. Until his death in 1974, he continued to fight for this cause.
